




AZIMUTH

Today, the reference plane for an *azimuth* is typically true north, measured as a 0° *azimuth*, though other angular units (grad, mil) can be used. Moving clockwise on a 360 degree circle, east has *azimuth* 90°, south 180°, and west 270°.





